### NOMINATION CRITERIA

The Eagle Scout Mother's Reception was initiated in 2013 to honor the Eagle Moms in the Baltimore Area Council, for their dedication and support to Scouting and raising an Eagle Scout.

Each year, the Baltimore Area Council honors one mom whose contributions to the community exemplify the ideals of the Boy Scouts of America as expressed in the Scout Oath and Law. The honoree has a wide influence within the community and is respected and held in high esteem by her peers.

The nomination criteria is as follows:

1. The individual must be the mother of an Eagle Scout from the Baltimore Area Council.
2. The individual must be a resident of Maryland.
3. The individual must have contributed, in some way, to improving the quality of life for the people of Maryland – through home, work, community service, volunteer efforts, or combination thereof.
4. The individual should be exemplary – someone who serves as an appropriate role model for people of all ages and backgrounds to emulate.
5. The individual should be someone for whom at least two letters of support can be provided, and whose contributions can be detailed by the nominating agency, group or business.
6. The individual must be nominated by an organization, member of the community or an Eagle Scout.

Please provide as much information as possible about the candidate. Members of the Eagle Scout Mother's Reception Committee will review the nominations and select the honoree.
