Brotherhood Initiative & Award

Objective: Increase Chapter Brotherhood Conversions to 30% for both Youth & Adults
2021 Youth Target ~ 30 | 2021 Adult Target ~ 15

Approach:

1. Promote Brotherhood Conversions at every Unit Visit
2. Provide Brotherhood Conversion Support Information (Study Guide & Example Letter)
3. Potentially conduct local One Day Chapter Brotherhood
4. Develop Year Round Elangomat Program to help promote Conversions
5. Implement Chapter Brotherhood Conversion Recognition Award
 - a. Pocket Brotherhood Dangle bearing Chapter logo
 - b. Available to be earned by Youth & Adults
 - c. Requires Awardee to have earned Chapter Participation Award



SCOUTING'S NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

Youth Fellowship / GLM Initiative & Award

Objective: Have a contingent of at least 30 or more youth attend & participate in the Spring and Fall Fellowships / General Lodge Meetings for Lodge Officer Elections

Approach:

1. Promote attendance at all Gatherings and every Unit Visit
2. Increase weight of Fellowships towards Leadership Award from 1 point to 3 points
3. Implement Youth Fellowship / GLM Participation Recognition Award
 - a. Available to be earned only by Youth
 - b. Requires Awardee having earned Chapter Participation Award
 - c. Up to three Years will be available: Chapter Pocket Patch w/loop
 - d. 1st Year Silver Mylar Border, 2nd Year Red Mylar Border, 3rd Year Gold Mylar Border

- **Travel & Supervision:** Car Pooling from Park & Ride at Rt. 175 & Snowden River Parkway

 - These Adults will be responsible for the youth they drive for the event
- **Timing:**
 - 11:00AM: Meet at Park & Ride Rt. 175 and Snowden River Parkway
 - 11:00AM to 11:30AM: Check-in and Driver Assignments
 - 11:30AM: Depart for Camden Yards (Parking Lot B/C) – Chapter has Six(6) Parking Passes
 - 12:00PM: Arrive at stadium enter as Car Pool Groups / Go to Club Level Picnic Perch
 - 1:05PM: First Pitch / ~4:00PM Game ends
 - 4:00PM: After Game – Depart as Car Pool Groups return to Park & Ride
 - 5:00PM: Arrive at Park & Ride / Parents pick up youth

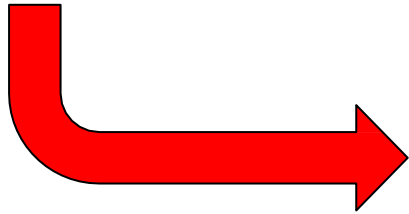
