

## **Council Recognition Banquet FAQ**

**Q:** I prefer to wear my uniform to this event, does BSA policy prohibit me from drinking alcoholic beverages?

**A:** No.

**Q:** With alcohol at this event, what is the appropriate attire?

**A:** The attire for this event is “come as you are comfortable.” Some volunteers will choose to come in uniform, and that is okay. Business casual and business dress are also appropriate attire. It is important to remember that the bar is not being provided/ paid for by the Baltimore Area Council but is simply present for those who chose to have a beverage.

**Q:** Can I bring my children?

**A:** Absolutely, however this is an adult recognition event and your child would not be attending as a youth member of the organization, but as a member of your family.

**Q:** Why does the location change from year to year?

**A:** Over the last few years the council has made an effort to have this event travel around the council. It is important to remember that no matter where the event is, it is a bit of a drive for many of us.

**Q:** What other awards are presented other than the Silver Beaver?
