A Den Chief is a Boy Scout who helps a Cub Scout Den with activities, advancement, ceremonies, crafts, and other Den events. If you think the Den Chief job is for you, plan to attend our Den Chief Training Course! This is not a "sit down and take notes" course. You will learn how to be a great Den Chief, and you will leave the training with a whole bunch of new games, songs, tricks, and puzzles to help you in your new leadership position. Even Den Chiefs who have served for a while will get some new "tricks" to make you even better!

Submasters and Pack Leaders - Ask your local Scout Troop to provide your Pack with Den Chiefs. You won't regret it! Den Chiefs will help you to have stronger Dens, better retention of your Cub Scouts, and better Webelos-to-Scout transition results. Webelos Den Chiefs are especially useful for teaching the Boy Scout portions of the Webelos advancement program, and they give your Webelos a friend in a local Troop when it's time to graduate. You will not regret investing in the Den Chief program!

Scoutmasters and Troop Leaders - Being a Den Chief qualifies as a leadership position for rank advancement. Encourage your Scouts to consider the Den Chief position – and make sure they sign up for training! A good Den Chief can help to funnel Webelos to your Troop!

Cub Scout Den Chief



Qualifications: An older Boy Scout, Varsity Scout, or Venturer. Selected by the SPL and approved by the Scoutmaster, Varsity Scout Coach, or Venturing Advisor at the request of the Cubmaster. Approved by the Cubmaster and Den Leader. Registered as a youth member of a Troop, Team, or Crew.

Responsibilities: The Cub Scout Den Chief's responsibilities are to:

- Know the purposes of Cub Scouting.
- Help Cub Scouts achieve the purposes of Cub Scouting.
- Serve as the activities assistant at Den meetings.
- Set a good example through attitude and uniforming.
- Be a friend to the boys in the Den.
- Help Den Leader/Assistant Den Leader lead weekly Den meetings.
- Help the Den in its part of the monthly Pack meeting.
- Know the importance of the monthly theme and Pack meeting plans.
- Meet regularly with the Den Leader to review meeting plans.
- Meet as needed with adult members of the Den, Pack, and Troop.
- Receive training from the Den Leader (and Cubmaster or Assistant Cubmaster) and attend Den Chief Training.
- Encourage Cub Scouts to become Webelos Scouts when they are eligible.
- Help the Denner and Assistant Denner to be leaders.
