## *Information on Competition*

We will be enjoying a weekend with games and activities for all Webelos and Scouts BSA age groups.

We will continue with the type of format used at Operation Icicle having games throughout the day. The activities will be based on the Boy Scout Athletics Merit Badge and the Webelos Stronger, Faster Higher Fitness badge. Some of the activities you can expect are as follows:

**Awards and Recognition** – the competition will be a combination of individual activities and team sports. For the **Individual activities** we will break the competition into the following age groups: Webelos Scouts: all ages. The Scouts BSA members: 11 – 13, 14 – 16, 17 and above. We will recognize for each activity first, second and third place. Here is a partial list of individual activities: push-ups (1 minute time), sit-ups (1 minute time), baseball throw for accuracy, baseball throw for distance (3 throws for total distance), football (3 tries – longest recorded) punt, pass, kick, soccer kick for accuracy, basketball throws for accuracy, 20 yard dash, 50 yard dash, 100 yard dash. **Team Games** (in a round robin format): wiffle ball, soccer and touch football or kick ball.

You won't want to miss all the fun, so please come and enjoy a fun filled day of games and activities.

### **The price of registration**

- 1.) \$10.00 per person (scouts and adults) which covers the campsite and program materials. All units are to provide their own food and cook as a group (great experience for all (WEBELOS and Scouts BSA members).
- 2.) Scouts are welcome to come for the day but must pre-register with their unit (pack or troop) and be labeled on the roster, the price remains the same.

**Registration:** Will take place at the August Roundtable, and September Roundtable or online. At that time we will need your unit number (pack or troop), contact information, number of scouts and dens or patrols, and number of adult members. Campsites will be assigned and Groups notified of their assignments in September. Registration will be on a first come first served basis and may need to be limited to maintain safe operation at Broad Creek. **Final payment** (in the form of a Unit Check) and **3 copies** of your **final Unit Roster** need to be turned into the Dining Hall between **6pm – 9pm on Friday October 11. Even if you have registered online I will still need a final draft of your unit roster.**

**Parking Considerations:** There is limited parking at Camp Oest. We ask that each group carpool as much as possible. Participants will need to plan to stay for the entire weekend. We will have parking attendants at the parking lot and ask that you park where directed to. We will require you to park in closely. We have

noticed in past years that people leave too much space between vehicles and end up wasting parking space. We will provide a car registration to be displayed in your front windshield so that we can contact you if your car needs to be moved. If you do not already have this done before arrival, the Parking Attendant will require you to fill out the form. Also there will be absolutely NO parking down by the administration buildings. Please let your group's parents know this. If a vehicle is in this area, and I cannot contact the owner, I will have it towed at the owner's expense.

**Volunteer Staff and Judges:** We are requesting that each Group (Webelos Dens and Scouts BSA Troops) provide at least two adults or older scouts to help run the stations during the day. If they need documentation of service hours, then let the Program Director know.
