



## 2022 Unit Recharter Update

The Boy Scouts of America's Annual Recharter process is changing. In an effort to improve systems and increase speed and efficiency in process, the current Internet Recharter System will be phased out by the National Council, BSA.

This change by the National Council directly impacts the Baltimore Area Council's units, all of which are set to expire on December 31, 2021. The 2022 Recharter process will be completed through a new system located in Internet Advancement 2.0

More information on the roll out of this new system is expected on or around September 1, 2021. The new system is set to launch on October 15<sup>th</sup> and will not be available prior to then.

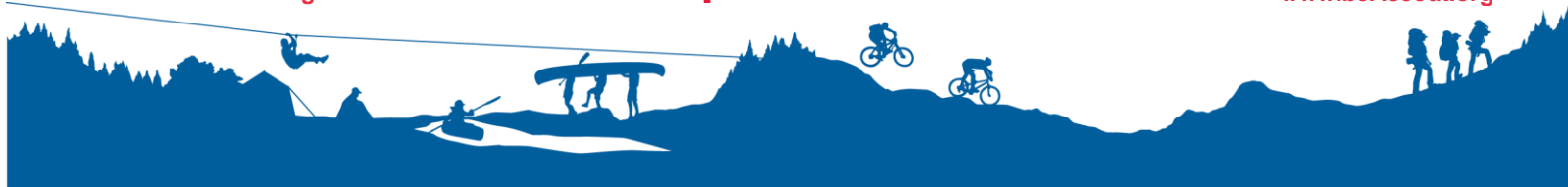
### Recharter Timeline:

Follow the timeline, see helpful hints below to avoid falling behind.

- September 1- more information released regarding new system by the National Council.
- After September 1 – Baltimore Area Council provides additional information to units.
- October 15- Units have access to new system.
- Download Roster when available.
- December 1<sup>st</sup> – Completed Charter due to BAC.

### Helpful Hints for Recharter- What you can be doing NOW to get ahead:

- Communicate with your Charter Partner so they know Recharter is coming.
- Ensure you have updated contact information for all Members.
- Verify that all adults have updated their Youth Protection Training.
  - Youth protection training must be valid for the duration of 2022 (the entire charter period).
- Contact Youth that may not have attended recently and ask if they intend to continue.
- Remember that to be an active member of the Order of the Arrow- you must be a registered member of the BSA.
- Collect membership fees early! Please see the updated prorated fees on the back.
- Request a BLANK Check from your Treasurer- this makes the process smoother.
- Think about important Events in 2022 such as: Scouting For Food, Blue and Gold/ Courts of Honor, a Friends of Scouting Presentation, Summer Camp – information on all of these items are requested as part of the Recharter Process.
- Talk with your leadership about Unit Journey to Excellence.
