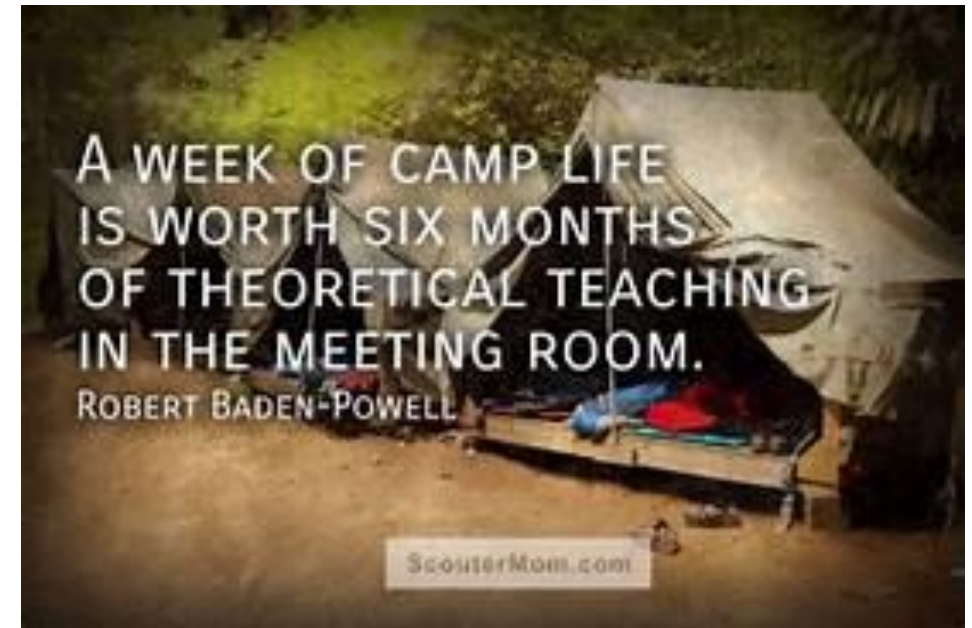

# Virtual Trip Basics

Trip should resemble physical trip

Zoom or other platform

Check backyards for reception

Videos always on

Breakouts for cooking & activities



# Physical Trip Similarities

Site selection, setting up & sleeping in tent  
Cooking on stoves normally Troop uses  
PLC directed program activities  
Campfire  
Bugle calls if normally done



# Cooking – Tenderfoot & 2 Class

- Troop Guides teach Scouts
- Propane stove safety training
- SPL approved menu, two weeks in advance
- Scouts buy food (themselves & family)
- Only menu food allowed – no house calls
- 3-Step wash station used
- Requirements signed off by normal Troop method



# Cooking – First Class

Grubmaster appointed

Menu approved by SPL 2 weeks in advance

Scouts buy listed food (themselves & family)

Only menu food allowed – no house calls

Each Scout must have equipment (trail stove, Dutch oven, etc)

Grubmaster takes Scouts step-by-step through cooking

3-Step wash station used

Grubmaster reviews results from each Scout

Requirements signed of by normal Troop method



# Cooking – Merit Badges

Grubmaster appointed, Blue Card from Scoutmaster

Menu approved by SPL 2 weeks in advance by Counselor

Each Scout must have equipment (trail stove, Dutch oven, etc)

Cooking methods approved

Scouts buy listed food (themselves & family)

Only menu food allowed – no house calls

Grubmaster takes Scouts step-by-step

3-Step wash station used

Grubmaster reviews results from each Scout

Requirements signed of by Counselor





# Activities - Overall

Break rooms can be setup Round Robin  
Sessions should not be over 1.5 hours each

Counselor approves program.

Scout Emcee contacts Scouts to be in program.

An adult may include an actual fire.

Scouts must have Scoutmaster approved adult Fire Marshall for actual fire.

Counselor should attend campfire.

Emcee & Counselor review results for sign off.
