

2021 WOR Leaders Guide

Due to Covid-19 Webelos-O-Ree is going to look much different. On Saturday and Sunday there will be two sessions offered each day. The first session will start at 9am with arrival at 8am for medical check in. The second session will start at 1pm with arrival at 12am for medical check in. Each session will have space for 10 dens of ten scouts each. Due to the limit den and scout slots we ask that packs consolidate dens if possible. When you enter Camp Safran you will be directed where to park. Dean Leaders, once your den has arrived please come to the Administration Building and check in. We ask that Den Leaders collect the dens medical screening questionnaire to turn in. Each Den will be given a map of the trail. Each station on the trail should take 15 minutes to complete. Do not expect to complete all the stations on the trail.

Before traveling to camp all individuals must follow these guidelines:

The WOR Pre Event Screening Form should be reviewed in its entirety and if they answer "YES" to any question they are asked to stay at home. Each participant (scout or Parent) must bring a completed and signed WOR Medical Screening Questionnaire. Only the Scout and their parent shall enter Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation. All others shall stay at home. (No Pets)

All Participants are encouraged to wear a face mask when social distancing is not possible.

Each participant should bring an extra face mask and hand sanitizer.

A daypack with water, and raingear is strongly suggested.
