2) Memorial Day Flag Placement

I am assisting Chuck as the Capitol District coordinator for the Memorial Day Services and Flag Placement at Crownsville's Veteran's Cemetery. An agenda is in draft at this time and cannot be confirmed until we have all the players in place. But for planning purposes:

The ceremony is Saturday, May 28th at 8 am.

It is "extremely" important that adults understand, the county police does not want us parking on the street. And they may give tickets to those that do.

Safety is our first concern. That is a main road and we do not want anyone to get hurt.

There is plenty of parking inside the cemetery and no one will get blocked in. Placing flags only takes a matter of 15 minutes and scouters will be departing at different times. There will not be any backup leaving the cemetery.

The gates "will not open" before 730. That is the cemetery requirement. We have to wait for their staff to be in place before we enter.

The gates for the Cemetery do not open until 0730. We start the Ceremony promptly at 0800 with the invocation. There is plenty of time to park and get to the ceremony before it starts.

At 0830 we will start placing the Flags.

The Cemetery is located on Sunrise Beach Rd. in Crownsville.

A change this year is that there will not be any refreshments. We ask that leaders insure their scouts bring their individual water containers and any snacks they may need.
